RULES OF THE ROAD:

All teams from the same club no longer all have to pick the same day. However once a team declares their day of play (weekend vs. weekday) they must play on this designated day throughout their entire time in the tournament. You cannot switch once you declare your day type.

Usually the weekday teams play on a Monday and the weekend teams play on a Saturday. However, if these days are an issue, you may play on another day if the teams involved agree. Teams can independently pick preferred day of play.

1. It is a 2-person better ball NET tournament. Half the field will advance after each round, based on the lowest scores.
2. Each club can send as many teams as they want. All teams must go through their SNEWGA Rep. Substitutes can be made over the course of the tournament.
3. Once a player (as a player or a sub) has been eliminated in any round, that player cannot be a substitute on a team that is still playing
4. The teams will be divided into Regions depending on the number of teams, number of clubs and the play day (weekend versus weekday).
5. The tournament is anticipated to run 4-5 weeks starting in mid May.
6. The Region winners will participate in the semi-final. The two final teams will play for the championship in a match play format.
7. The final round will be played on a weekend at a neutral site.
