## 2. PACE OF PLAY TIP SET #3, HOW TO CATCH UP

As we continue to focus on Pace of Play this year, tip set #3 illustrates ways to catch up if you fall behind:

**Tip #7** Play ready golf, as frequently as possible, even on the tee. This is especially helpful if someone needs a bathroom break or gets caught in a difficult position, like needing to determine drop options for unplayable lie or casual water, or how to execute a shot from behind a tree or next to a rock, etc.

**Tip #8** Be helpful to others in your group. Watch your fellow competitors' errant shots, as well as your own. If everyone watches the ball, the group as a whole has a better chance of finding it quickly. Volunteer to fill in a divot or rake a bunker for another player, if needed. Pick up another player's equipment if they've left it on the "wrong" side of the green. Be ready to attend the flagstick for others.

**Tip #9** Putt out (continuous putting). Unless you can't avoid stepping into someone else's line in order to putt out, put the ball into the hole if your last putt is within a foot or two.

Remember, a few seconds per player per hole, **can add up to as much as 50 minutes per round per group!** Golf isn't a race, but let's pick up the pace!
